Blue Box 2009 Highlights

The following items are all accepted recyclable material:

- Metal cans, aluminum foil and pie plates
- Plastic containers, clear and foam plastic cups, trays and packaging (NO blister or bubble packs, prescription bottles or toys)
- **Empty** aerosol & paint cans (NO plastic paint cans, propane cylinders or other hazardous waste)
- Boxboard & mixed paper (NO tissue, paper towel or laminated paper. Do NOT put paper loose in blue box.)
- Plastic bags (clean) – bundle separately (NO meat, cheese or stretch wrap, cereal box liners or chip bags)
- Bottles & jars (NO other types of glass such as kitchenware ceramics, dishes, drinking glasses, window glass, light bulbs or mirrors)
- Corrugated cardboard – bundled (NO waxed boxes, soiled pizza boxes or pickup from businesses and institutions)
- Newspapers & magazines – bag office paper separately in clear bags (NO soiled newspapers. Keep boxboard and mixed paper separate, not mixed with newspaper and magazines.

Remember:

- Blue boxes can be purchased at the Municipal Office

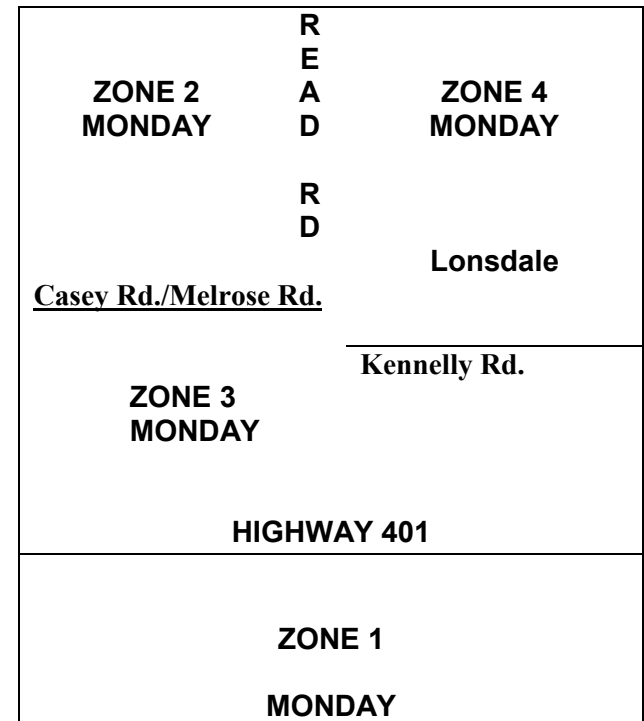

Location:

6663 Old Highway 2 (1/2 mile east of Salmon River Motel)

Hours of Operation:

- Wednesdays: Noon to 4:00 p.m.
- Saturdays: 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Site Regulations:

- Only bagged garbage and major appliances/large household furnishings accepted
- Bagged garbage must be placed in bins
- Max bag size = 26" x 37"
- Max bag weight = 40 lbs.

Fees:

- Bagged garbage - \$2.00 per bag
- Major appliances and large household furnishings - \$10.00 each
- Refrigeration appliances - \$30.00 each (includes Freon removal)

Items Not Accepted at Site:

- Hazardous waste / Construction debris
- Farm waste / Yard waste (including leaves & grass clippings)
- Recyclable material
- Automotive parts / Tires
- For items not accepted at our site, please call QWS at 613-394-6266 or 1-800-210-0762 for details on where these items can be discarded.

Recycling Information

Tyendinaga Township contracts all recycling (& hazardous waste) activity through “Quinte Waste Solutions” (Centre & South Hastings Waste Services Board). This organization is recognized as the leader in waste reduction programs throughout Ontario. If you have any questions or concerns regarding any of the programs, do not hesitate to call the numbers noted in this pamphlet.

Recycling Pick Up Details

- Pick up is scheduled every two weeks – on opposite Mondays depending on your Zone.
- Set out your blue box(s) & other containers before **7:00 am**. At least one blue box must be with containers.
- Place blue box(s) on right hand side of road based on the direction the truck goes down your road.
- Material must be separated into proper categories.
- If your collection day falls on a public holiday, it will remain to be picked-up that day (excluding Christmas Day & New Year’s Day).
