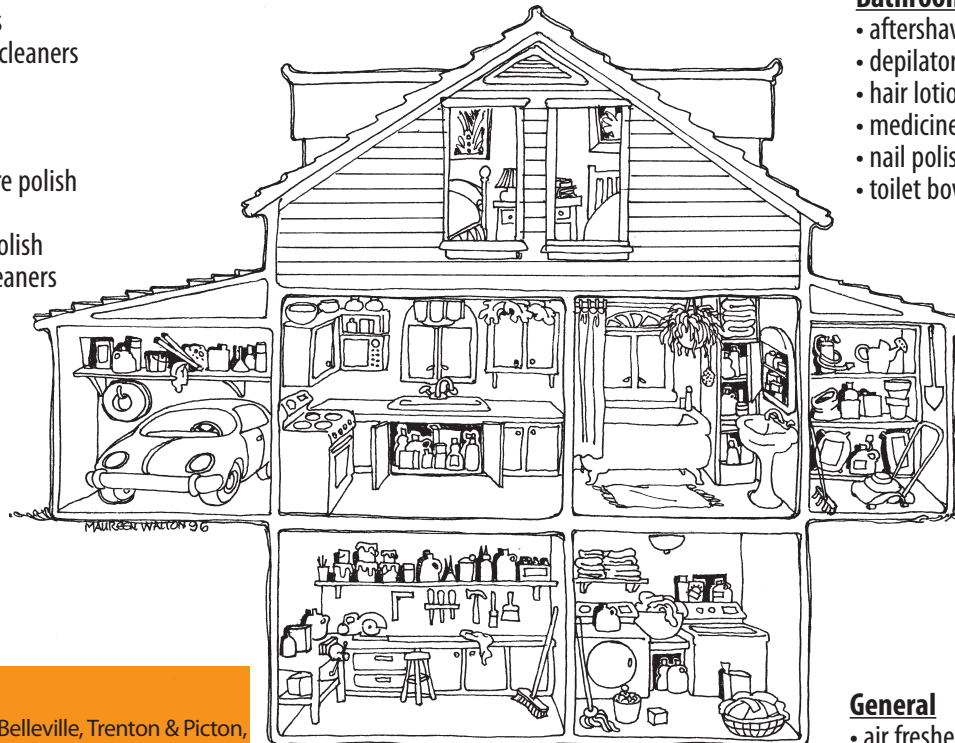
...bring any of these items to a Household Hazardous Waste Event

Kitchen

- abrasive powders
- ammonia-based cleaners
- chlorine bleach
- disinfectants
- drain decloggers
- floor and furniture polish
- oven cleaners
- metal cleaners/polish
- window, glass cleaners

Garage

- transmission fluid
- battery & battery acid
- brake fluid
- body filler
- auto spray paint
- car wax
- fuel (kerosene, diesel, gas)
- windshield washer fluid
- radiator antifreeze



Bathroom

- aftershave, perfume
- depilatories
- hair lotions, dyes
- medicines
- nail polish and remover
- toilet bowl cleaner

Garden Shed

- fertilizers
- pesticides
- rat & mouse poison
- roach & ant poison
- propane tanks
- pool chemicals

Laundry

- chlorine bleach
- stain removers

General

- air fresheners
- batteries (alkaline & rechargeable)
- butane cylinders
- lighter fluid
- fluorescent tubes & bulbs
- shoe polish

Workshop

- rust remover
- stains, finishes
- thinners & turpentine
- wood preservatives
- mothballs
- flea collars & sprays
- paint strippers

- driveway sealer
- used oil filters

Restrictions

- No Motor Oil
- Fluorescent tubes - 24 tubes (8' max length)
- Propane tanks - up to 100 lb.

 - Canadian Tire - Belleville, Trenton & Picton, - 20 litre max. 10¢/litre
 - Shaw's Auto (please call first) 613-966-8001
- Ammunition Explosives & flares**
 - call local OPP 1-888 310-1122
- Fluorescent Light Ballasts**
 - may contain PCB's - call Quinte Waste Solutions
- Syringes/Medicine**
 - contact a local Pharmacy regarding a return program
- Smoke Detectors**
 - landfill
- H'hold appliances**
 - Crawford Metal, local scrap metal dealer
- Disposable Batteries**
 - any Home Hardware, Home Depot, and "The Source".
- Propane cylinders**
 - **Not in the Blue Box!** bring to an HHW event

* Empty paint (lids off) and aerosol cans go in the Blue Box

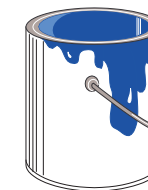
