

Invitation to Tender Canteen Services Tyendinaga Township

The Township of Tyendinaga operates two canteens during the summer months. The first is the south canteen which generally supports our summer soccer program but also has sales related to baseball. The second canteen is the north canteen and primarily services the Youth and South Hastings Baseball League.

Terms of Tender

The Contractor will:

1. Work closely with Tyendinaga Minor Soccer, Tyendinaga Youth Baseball and the South Hastings Baseball League in matters relating to scheduling, operations and canteen availability to participants and spectators
2. Operate during the months of mid May-September – (conclusion of SHBL playoffs)
3. Be open for the soccer (10 weeks) and entire baseball playing season (Youth and SHBL)
4. Will be open on rain dates for SHBL and rescheduled Youth Baseball League games
5. Sell only confectionary items i.e. :
 - a. Healthy snacks
 - b. Pop / water/ flavoured drinks
 - c. Chips
 - d. Chocolate bars
 - e. Freezies
 - f. Other confection and candy
6. Only resell food – no cooked or prepared items
7. Work closely with Quinte Health Care and the Health Inspector so that we are operating the cleanest of facilities
8. Do all purchasing and transportation of goods for resale
9. Keep the canteens clean
10. Allow the Soccer and Baseball Associations to run the canteen during tournaments as a fundraiser (1-2 school tournaments, 1-3 baseball league tournaments)

Council asks that any proponent submit to Council a proposal including a rental amount to be paid to the Township for the season and a description of the canteen services they intend to include. Proposals will be evaluated on: rental price – attention to scheduling – service to community
